RapitIT – ACL Masters Cup 2023

Tournament Format

- There are a total of 6 teams.
- These teams are divided into two pools, each with 3 teams.
- The tournament fee is \$200.
- Each team can have a maximum roster of 15 players.
- To participate in a final match, a player must have played at least 1 game in the round-robin stage.
- The games will be held at either Sharon Park or East Roswell Park, and they will consist of 12 overs per inning.
- The final match will feature the top team from each pool.
- Each team will provide umpires for one round robin game.
- ACL will do the field setup for round robin games.

Game Rules

- First 3 overs of power play
- Max of 4 players should be on either side of the wicket(off or on)
- Only 2 bowlers are allowed a maximum of 3 overs each.
- A Bye Runner is permitted.
- The Super Sub format will be in effect; please refer to the super-sub rule below.
- The rules of ACL F15 will be enforced unless specified here.
- There will be no application of the DLS (Duckworth-Lewis-Stern) method.
- Super over is not applicable during the Round Robin stage.
- A SuperOver will be used during the Play-offs.

Super sub-Rule

- A super-sub is allowed to either bowl or bat during the match (not both), but they can field at any time.
- The maximum number of fielders on the field is always 9 for F15 at any stage of the game.
- Both captains and umpires must be notified about the super-sub, and the player should be clearly identified.
- Umpires are required to capture a photograph of the playing 10 (F15) if the super-sub is participating.
- The super-sub (or any player, for that matter) can only be part of one team.
- The maximum number of wickets that can fall in a completed innings remains at 8 (F15).
- Each bowler is limited to a maximum of 3 overs for 2 bowlers and 2 overs for the remaining bowlers.
- The super-sub must be present on the field.
- Players joining late must be present at the ground before the commencement of the 6th over (F15) of the first inning of the match, with the umpires being informed upon their arrival.
