



Atlanta Cricket League Volunteer Vehicle Use Policy

Effective Date: January 10, 2026

Approved By: ACL Board of Directors

Applies To: Volunteers, Coaches, League Officials, Board Members, and Other Covered Individuals

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish requirements and risk-management standards for volunteers who operate personal, rented, or ACL-owned vehicles while performing services for Atlanta Cricket League (ACL). This policy is required for insurance coverage and organizational liability protection.

Scope

This policy applies to all ACL volunteers operating a motor vehicle for ACL-related activities, including events, practices, meetings, or transportation of equipment or individuals.

Policy Statement

ACL permits volunteers to operate vehicles only if they meet eligibility requirements and sign the Volunteer Vehicle Use Acknowledgement & Attestation Form. ACL does not conduct DMV or MVR checks and relies on volunteer self-certification.

Volunteer Eligibility Requirements

Volunteers must possess a valid driver's license, be legally permitted to drive, maintain required insurance, and comply with all laws and this policy.

Georgia Automobile Insurance Requirements

Volunteers must maintain at least:

\$25,000 bodily injury per person

\$50,000 bodily injury per accident

\$25,000 property damage

Personal insurance is primary.

Rental Vehicle Endorsement Clause

For rented vehicles, the volunteer's personal insurance is primary and ACL insurance, if any, is secondary and excess.

Prohibited Conduct

Driving under the influence, reckless driving, unauthorized use, or violation of laws is prohibited.

Accident Reporting

All accidents, injuries, or citations must be reported to ACL promptly.

Disclaimer

ACL does not verify license or insurance status and relies on volunteer attestations.

Enforcement

Non-compliance may result in revocation of driving privileges.

Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed periodically.
