



ACL Main League Rules Synopsis

Please find below the updated guidelines for the upcoming 2026 ACL season:

1. All players must ensure that their **legal name, and DOB** is updated in their profile.
2. All players must agree to all ACL policies, rules and regulations, with no exceptions
3. A player can only play in **only one league** either in F15 or T20, strict action will be implemented if found guilty of representation.
4. In the 2026 season, there will be a rematch for all washout/rained out (incomplete) games till Memorial Day weekend. All matches shall be rescheduled for a later day and will have reduced overs.
5. Any waist-high full toss above the striker's waist standing upright at the crease will be considered a no-ball. If the batter gets bowled, it will be an out.
6. No match credit will be given for washed-out games.
7. No match credit will be given for Rained-out games which are eligible for rescheduling. (For example, if a game gets rained out before Memorial Day and it gets rescheduled for a later day then player won't get credit for the rained out game)
8. Match credit will be given for any incomplete game if at least a single ball is bowled.
9. A player must play at least 30% of the matches during the Round Robin phase to take part in the playoffs.
10. DLS MUST be used for both T20 & F15. Please refer to the ACL DLS Rules for more information.
11. Additional players can be added to the roster with a fee of \$50 per player for T20 and \$25 for F15 till the team reaches the maximum cap.
12. Matches MUST start on the scheduled match time with no grace period.
13. The assigned umpires MUST arrive at least **15 minutes before** the scheduled match start time on the day of the match, and the toss must be completed 15 minutes before the scheduled start time.
14. For F15 - Powerplay will be followed for both Div 1 and Div 2
15. For F15 - if the ball bounces more than once or rolls along the ground before reaching the crease, it will be considered a dead ball.
16. For T20 - Drink Breaks will be for 5 minutes after the 10th over is complete, and this break MUST be taken inside the field.
